WELCOME VICTORIA MYMUDES!





Be Our Guest- In ALPHA! Starting Tuesday, August 6th 6:00-8:00 PM

St. James will be starting our fifth ALPHA course on August 6th.

An ALPHA course is an opportunity to grapple with the bigger questions of life and faith in a fun, nonthreatening, nonjudgmental environment.

ALPHA was originally designed for people who would not necessarily identify as churchgoers or Christians, but we find that it is equally valuable to ANYONE who wants to feel closer to God and His Church.

ALPHA is an 11-week course, meeting from 6:00-8:00pm on Tuesday evenings in the parish hall. It also includes one Saturday retreat day. There is no cost to participate in the program. Please consider joining us and, also, inviting people in your life that may be searching for answers to their spiritual questions.

Each evening starts with a shared supper, continues with a short video about some aspect of Christianity, and concludes with small group discussions. In the small group discussions, we encourage guests to raise any ideas, perspectives, questions, doubts, or objections they have. You can say as much or as little as you wish.
